## 2019-2020 COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

#### **Executive Committee**



The Executive Committee shall consist of the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and one (1) Director-at-Large. The Executive Committee shall meet and conduct the business of the Corporation, when necessary, between regularly scheduled Board meetings. Additionally, the Executive Committee is responsible for personnel issues including monitoring of annual review, compensation, and employment law. All decisions made by the Executive Committee during these interim periods must be ratified by the Board of Directors at the next regularly scheduled or special meeting. The President shall preside at meetings of the Executive Committee. The Executive Director shall serve on the Executive Committee in an ex-officio capacity.

#### **Governance Committee**



The Governance Committee is responsible for the ongoing review and recommendation to enhance the quality and future viability of the Board. This Committee is responsible for the annual board self-assessment, board succession planning, and the annual review of the by-laws, as well as serving as the Grievance Committee for any formal grievances against the Board Chair. The Governance Committee will select and prepare a slate of officers and new members to present to the board for approval at the May meeting of the Board of Directors. No member of the Governance Committee may be nominated for election to the Executive Committee while he or she is then serving as a member of this committee. The Board of Directors shall appoint five (5) members to serve on the Governance Committee and designate the Chairperson.

#### **Audit & Finance Committee**



The Audit & Finance Committee shall advise the Board on all financial matters, support the development of the annual budget, interpret the overall financial health of the organization, recommend the accounting firm to conduct the annual review of the Corporation, and perform such other duties as the President or Board may request. The Treasurer shall serve as Chairperson of the Audit & Finance Committee. The Board of Directors shall appoint an additional four (4) members to serve on the Audit & Finance Committee. The President, Executive Director, and other necessary staff shall serve on the Audit & Finance Committee in an ex-officio capacity. Additionally, this committee will have oversight over the Investment Committee.

#### COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS CONTINUED

#### **Investment Committee**

The Investment Committee shall report directly to and its oversight shall be the responsibility of the Finance Committee of the Foundation. It shall be devised with a minimum of three members and shall meet no less than annually to accomplish, at a minimum the following:

- 1. a review of Portfolio performance and composition and adherence to Policy guidelines
- 2. an assessment of the Foundation's liquidity needs and assurance that the Portfolio adequately provides for requisite liquidity, and
- 3. an assessment of adequacy of designated investment manager, if any, and a review of associated fees assessed and management performance.

#### **Creative Impact Grants Committee**



The Grants Committee shall make recommendations for the award of application grants made with funds of the Corporation pursuant to the guidelines that may be established by the Board of Directors and federal or state law. The Board of Directors shall appoint at least five (5) and no more than nine (9) members to serve on the Grants Committee and designate the Chairperson.

#### **Development Committee**

The Development Committee is responsible for on-going strategic planning of fund development. Responsibilities include the identification, solicitation, and cultivation of prospects in conjunction with staff and board members. Specific areas will include:

- 1. **Alumni Engagement** Responsible for cultivating relationships with alumni in an effort to gain support of the Foundation through participation in events and ultimately financial donations. Members will serve as ambassadors and advocates for both the Lawrence Township School Foundation and MSD of Lawrence Township.
- 2. **Legacy Society** Increase awareness and build relationships with those interested in planned giving opportunities.
- 3. **President's Leadership Council** (Donors who give \$1,000+ unrestricted donation) Focus is on donor engagement at this level of giving.

#### **Scholarship Committee**



The Scholarship Committee shall make recommendations for the award of scholarships made with funds of the Corporation pursuant to the guidelines that may be established by the Board of Directors and federal or state law. The Board of Directors shall appoint at least five (5) and no more than nine (9) members to serve on the Scholarship Committee and designate the Chairperson.

#### **Special Events Committees**

These committees are responsible for all matters pertaining to special event planning and execution for the Foundation. Current committees:

- 3. Bridge Fund Golf Outing
